### Sports Partnership £1300

The Watford and Hertsmere School Sports Partnership is a partnership of Infant, Primary, Secondary and Special Schools across Watford, Bushey, Borehamwood and Potters Bar. The Partnership, established in 2004, is based at Queens' School, Bushey.



The team consists of Partnership Staff including the School Sport Development Manager and Competition Manager who are based at Queens' School. Another member of the core team is the School Support Coach and Trainer who works across all Schools in the Partnership. In addition there are School Sports Co-ordinators who assist a number of Primary and Infant Schools.

The team work together to increase participation in High Quality Physical Education and School Sport through co-ordinated PE, school sport and out-of-school-hours learning activities that link with local community sports facilities, clubs and development programmes. The Partnership offers opportunities for young people to experience

different sports, engage in leadership and volunteering and take part in competition, including the School Games Programme which leads through to the Herts School Games.

### **Impact**

Working with the Sports Partnership has enabled pupils to compete against other schools in activities such as speed stacking and participate in the School Games Programme.

The school achieved Gold Award in the school games for the third consecutive year.

We have also used the partnership to develop playleader training for the children to lead and promote games and activities during break and lunch times.

### **Swimming Subsidy £4000**

#### **Impact**

Subsidising the cost of the pool, teacher, lifeguards and travel coach hire allowing all pupils to participate in swimming lessons in years 4-6.

### **Sports Equipment £640**

#### **Impact**

Purchasing a range of equipment including:

- Netball posts
- Skills sets
- Hoops
- Tennis & Badminton equipment
- Skipping Ropes

Has enabled more pupils to participate in a wider range of sports throughout the school day.

Before school and lunchtime clubs use the resources, alongside all class teachers who are able to include a wider range of activities in their PE classes.

Older equipment has been reallocated for use by playleaders at lunchtime.

### **Travel £750**

#### **Impact**

Enables pupils to participate in competitions and events.

### **Stomp Workshop £800**

#### **Impact**

Opportunity for children to take part in unusual activity and CPD training for staff in teaching dance that can be used in class based PE lessons.

### **Skip2Bfit Workshop £380**

#### **Impact**

Opportunity for children to take part in unusual activity and CPD training for staff in teaching dance that can be used in class based PE lessons.

Promote healthy activity outside school and enable children to make healthy decisions.

Class set of skipping ropes to be used in PE lessons teaching children skills and activities that can be used at home as well as in school.

### **Fitter Futures Subscriptions £449**

#### **Impact**

Promoting exercise and healthy living to all pupils. Exercise activities that can be used in class. Children can log their personal activities to raise awareness of personal health and fitness.

Organiser will be hosting an assembly for all children.

### **PE Conference £100**

#### **Impact**

Part of the Sports Partnership.

Upskilling of key staff leading to recruitment of Sports Apprentice and further sports opportunities for the school and pupils.

### **Sports Apprentice Summer Term £1470**

#### **Impact**

Will assist in the planning and organising of sporting events and activities across the school, and support class teachers in PE lessons allowing smaller group work.
