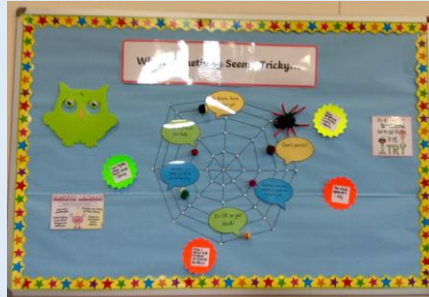

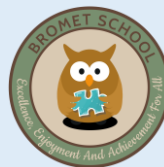

Meeting all of the children.

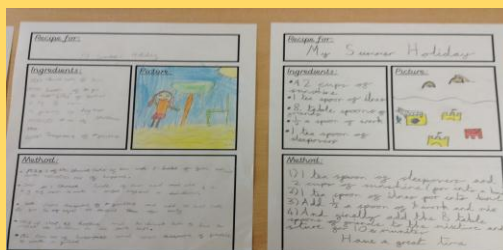
Do you have any children?

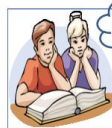
