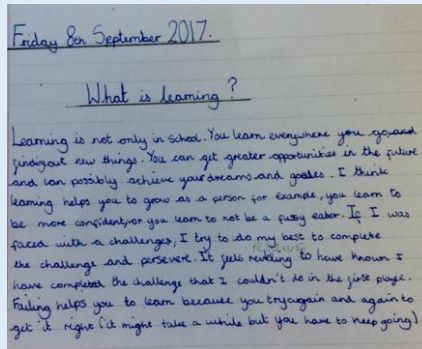

I enjoy gymnastics.

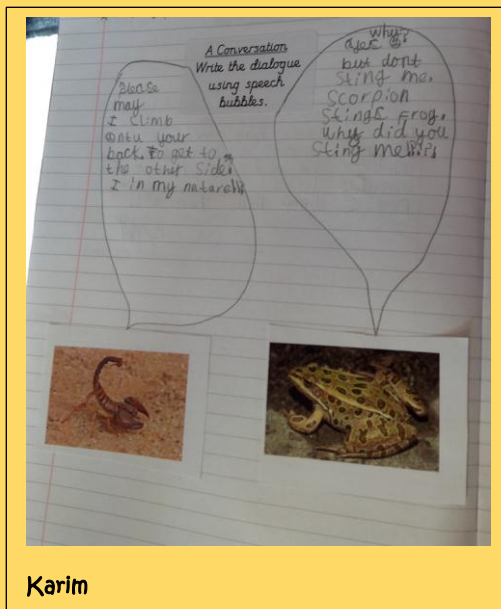
What is your favourite food?

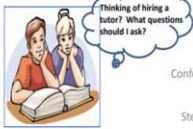
