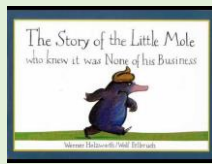
Let's Celebrate

My favourite reads... Miss Weyer



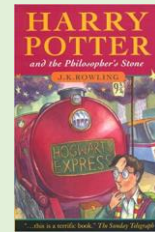
My favourite books were *Mystery Stories* when I was younger – they still are.
